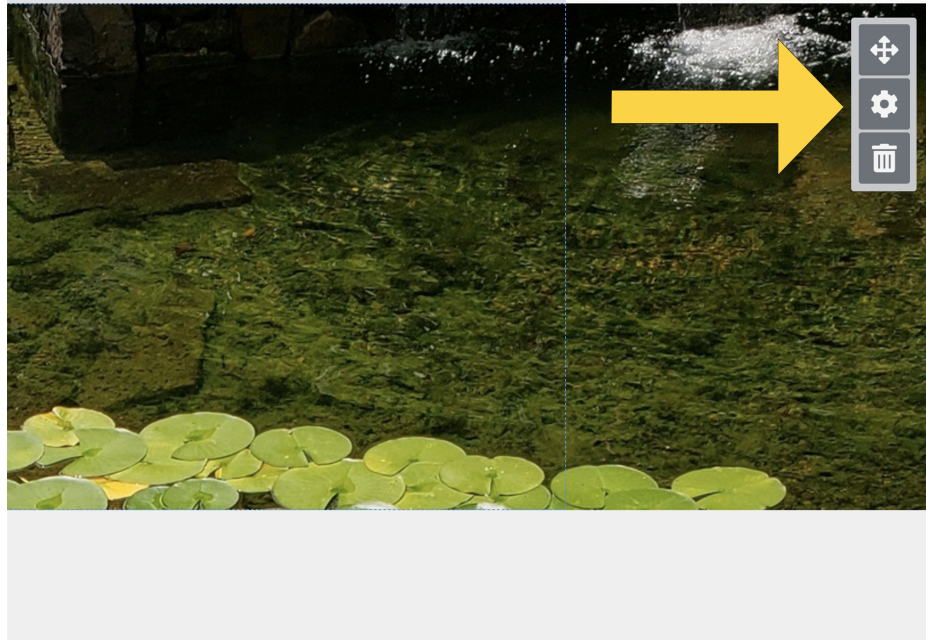


This tutorial instructs you on how to create parallax scrolling.

Parallax Scrolling will make the background layer photo move slower than the foreground layers when scrolling.

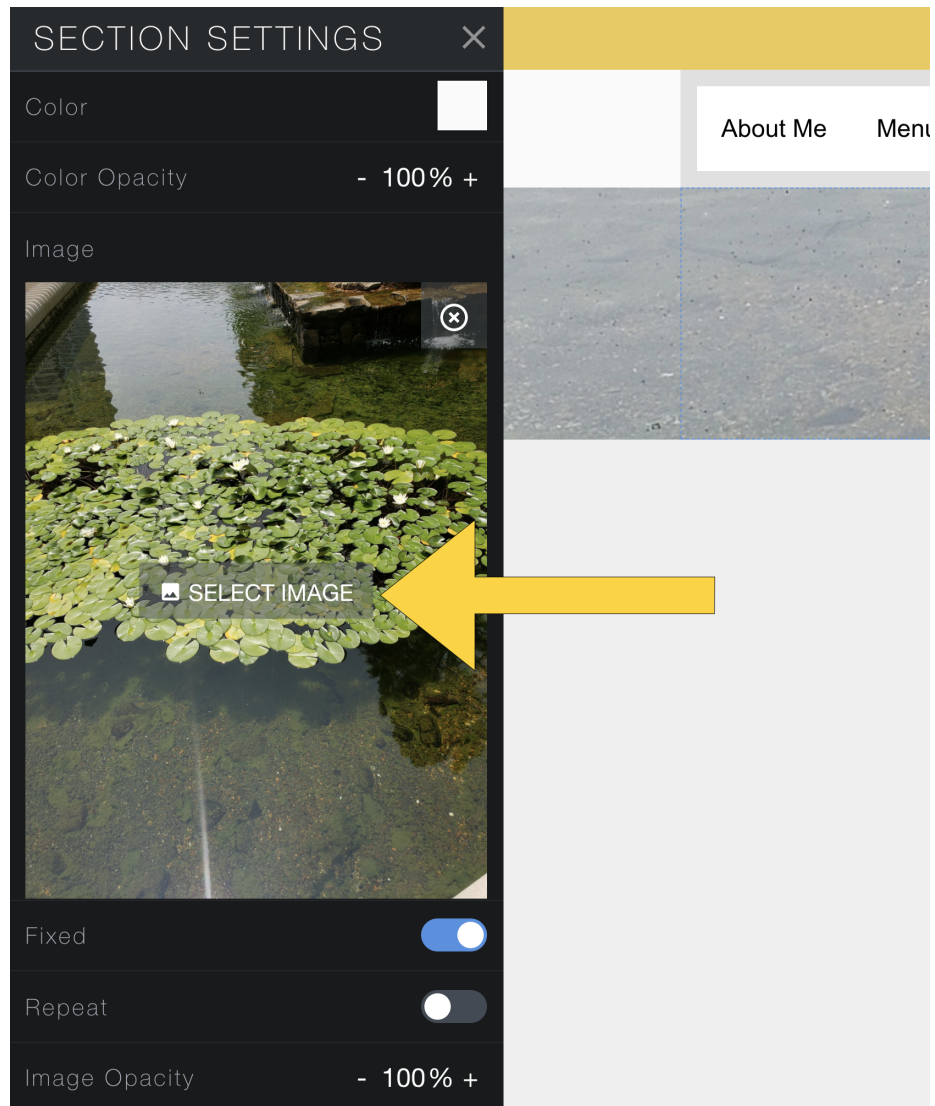
Step 1

To make the background photo do parallax scrolling, hover over the slide and click the settings icon.



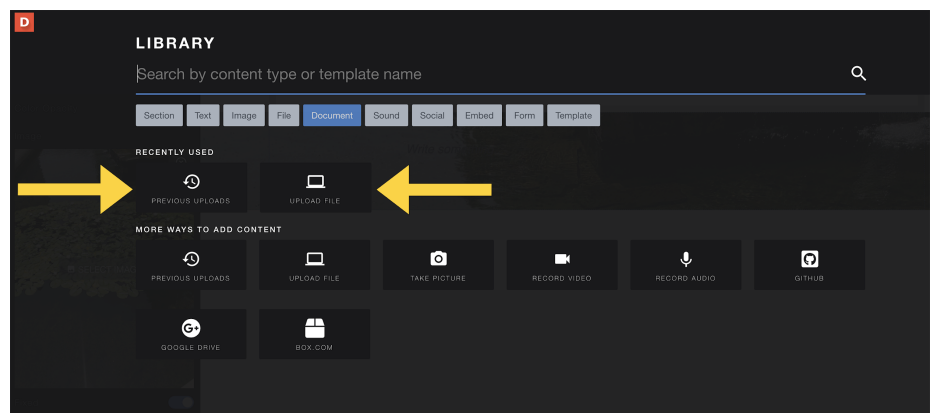
Step 2

Under bottom layer background, click select image.



Step 3

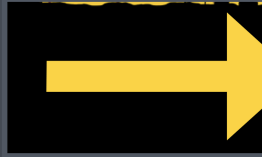
You can either select a photo by going to previous uploads or upload a new file.



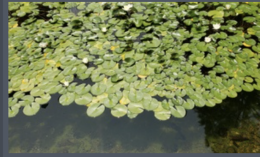
Step 4

Select the image you want to upload.

Step 5

To make the image able to do parallax scrolling, click the button next to fixed. When it is turned on, it is blue.

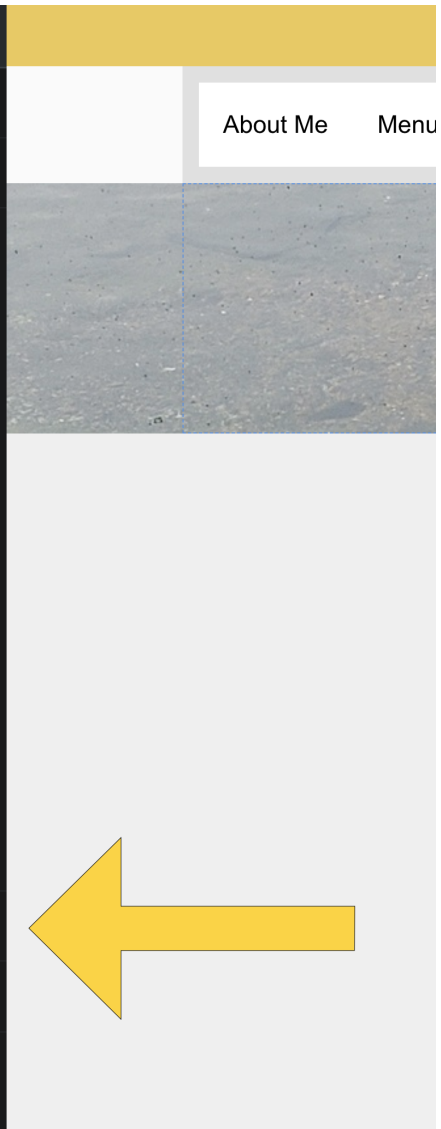
